## Registration

Registration for the Parlin-Ingersoll Public Library Summer Reading Program starts Monday, 5/16.

The program is for children ages 3 through 8th grade. The 6-week program runs from June 6-July 15. See the calendar for a complete schedule.

At registration, each child receives an event calendar and a time log, **which will remain in the library during the six week program.**

## Prize Cupboard

## Weekly Programs

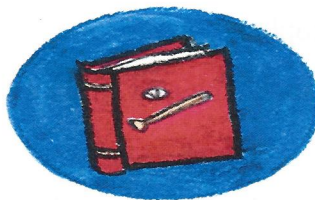
*Registration required. Age specific programs last 45 minutes and focus on a story, activities, songs, and crafts.*

The **Rookies** book group for children ages 3-5 years, meets on Monday mornings. You may choose either the 10am or 11am session.

The **Minor League** book group for kids who have finished grades K-2 meets on Tuesdays at 10am.

Students who have finished grades 3-4 may join the **All Stars** on Tuesdays at 2 pm.

If you have finished grades 5-8, join the **Major League** on Mondays at 3pm.



## Crafts

Crafts are Wednesdays from 1-3pm. Children may come anytime during those 2 hours to make the craft.

All materials are provided. The crafts are for all ages, but younger children may need parental assistance.

## Reading Rules

Any child from 3 years old through 8th grade may join the summer reading program.

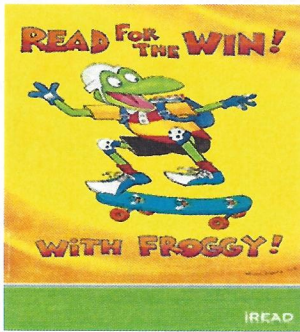
**Everyone can participate in the Summer Reading Program, but individual classes do fill up quickly so please register early.**

Pre-Readers may participate by listening to books read by parents or older siblings. Reading is tracked by minutes read (or listened to in the case of pre-readers).

Participants must read books from the library collection to reach their reading goal.

### Rules:

1. Register at library.
2. Read or listen to 120 minutes (2 hours) per week.
3. Read books at your reading level.
4. Record minutes in your log. (Logs are recorded in 15-min. increments)
5. Bring the time log to the children's desk to get stamped and to obtain your weekly prize. (One prize per week)
6. If you read more than the weekly goal, you may enter your name in the weekly prize box for a chance to win a larger prize!
7. Free Swim Party at Big Creek Park on 7/20 for those who read 12 hours. Parent and children attend free.
