Registration

Registration for the Parlin-Ingersoll Public Library Summer Reading Program starts Monday, 5/18, at the library.

The program is for children ages 3 through 8th grade. The 6-week program runs from June 8-July 18. See the calendar for a complete schedule.

At registration, each child receives an event calendar and a time log, which will remain in the library

Prize Cupboard

Readers who meet their weekly reading goal will earn a prize. Local businesses have donated a number of these prizes including food coupons, trinkets, and many other items.

Weekly Programs

Registration required. Agespecific programs last 45 minutes and focus on a story with games, songs, and crafts.

The **Wee-B-Jammin'** book group for children ages 3-5 meets on Monday mornings You may choose either the 10am or 11am session.

The **Rockin' Readers** book group for kids who have finished grades K-2 meets on Tuesdays at 10am.

Students who have finished grades 3-5 may join the **Sonic Youth** on Tuesdays at 2 pm.

If you have finished grades 5-8, join the **Beat Busters** on Mondays at 3pm.



Crafts

Crafts are Wednesdays from 1-3pm. Children may come anytime during those 2 hours to make the craft.

All materials are provided. The crafts are for all ages, but younger children may need parental assistance.

Reading Rules

Any child from 3 years old through 8th grade may join the summer reading program.

Pre-Readers may participate by listening to books read by parents or older siblings. Reading is tracked by minutes read (or listened to in the case of pre-readers).

Participants must read books from the library collection to reach their reading goal.

- 1. Read or listen to 120 minutes (2 hours) per week.
- 2. To complete the reading goal, read or listen to 12 hours by 7/18. (Last day to record minutes.)
- 3. Read library books at your reading level.
- 4. Record minutes in your log. (Logs are recorded in 15 minute increments)
- Bring the time log to the children's desk to get stamped and to obtain your weekly prize. (One prize per week)
- 6. If you read more than the weekly goal, you may enter your name in the weekly prize box for a chance to win a larger prize!
- 7. Free Swim Party at Big Creek Park on 7/22 for those who read 12 hours by 7/18. Parent and children attend free.
