Registration

Registration for the Parlin-Ingersoll Public Library Summer Reading Program starts Monday, 5/22.

The program is for children ages 2 through 8th grade. The 6-week program runs from June 5-July 14. See the calendar for a complete schedule. We host activities throughout each week.

At registration, each child receives an event calendar and a time log, **which will remain in the library during the six week program. Everyone can participate in the summer reading program, but individual classes do fill up quickly so please register early. However, we do offer many programs that do not require registration. The goal of summer reading is to encourage the love of reading.**

Incentives

Readers who meet their weekly reading goal will earn a prize. Local businesses have donated a number of these prizes including food coupons, trinkets, and many other items.

Weekly Classes

The **Doodlebug's** book group for children ages 2-3 years, meets on Monday mornings from 9:00-9:30 am.

The **Pint Sized Picasso's** book group for children ages 4-5 years, meets on Monday mornings from 10:00-10:45 am.

The **van Gogh's** book group for kids who have finished grades K-2 meets on Tuesdays. You may choose either the 10:00-10:45 am or 11:00-11:45 am session.

The **Warhol's** book group for kids who have finished grades 3-4 meets on Tuesdays from 2:00-2:45 pm.

If you have finished grades 5-8, join the **da Vinci's** book group on Mondays from 3:00-3:45 pm.



Crafts & Legos

Crafts are Wednesdays from 1-2:30 pm. Children may come anytime during the 1 1/2 hours to make the craft. It is a make and take craft.

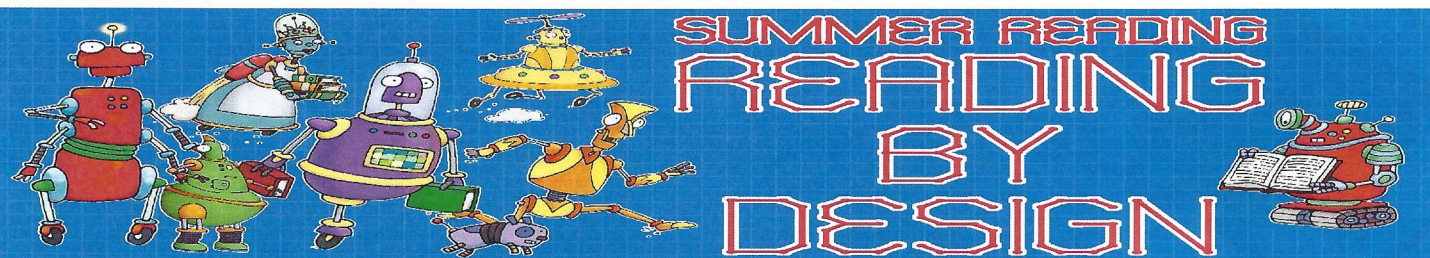
All materials are provided. The crafts are for all ages, but younger children may need parental assistance. Lego Club is also on Wednesdays from 3-4:00 pm. We will supply the blocks and you bring the imagination!

Reading Rules

Any child from 2 years old through 8th grade may join the summer reading program. Participants must read books from the library collection to reach their reading goal.

Rules:

1. Register at library.
2. Children in grades K-8th read or listen to 120 minutes (2 hours) per week. Parents of children ages 2-4 must read 10 books a week to their child.
3. Read books at your reading level.
4. Record minutes or books in your log.
5. Bring the time/book log to the children's desk to get stamped and to obtain your weekly prize. (One prize per week)
6. If you read more than the weekly goal, you may enter your name in the weekly prize box for a chance to win a larger prize!
7. Free Swim Party at Big Creek Park on 7/19 for those who read 12 hours. Parent and children attend free.
