Registration for the Parlin-Ingersoll Public Library Summer Reading Program starts Monday, May 17th. Registration will be accepted in-person, by phone (309-647-0328), e-mail (SummerReading@parliningersoll.org) or a private message through our Facebook page. Please be aware, we may not see your e-mail or message right away, but we will respond back when you are registered.

To register please send us your child's name, age, school, and grade recently completed. We will also need your phone number, street address, and email address. Publicity Release forms will need to be signed before we can take any pictures. If you take any pictures and would like to share them with us, please send them to SummerReading@parliningersoll.org.

*****If you feel your child needs an individualized reading goal chart, please mention it when you register.**

For all in-person programming to happen safely, masks are required for everyone ages 2 and up, social distancing must be maintained, and capacity restrictions will be followed. Because of social gathering limits, registration will be required for our Tie Dye events and Story Time sessions. We will have Toddler-Pre-K on Mondays, K-2nd on Wednesdays, and 3rd-8th on Fridays. There will be a morning session at 10am and an afternoon session at 3pm. All sessions are limited to 10 families, so please register for one session guaranteed* and one to be placed on the waitlist. All Story Times will be at Wallace Park near the pavilion. All craft days will be outside on the north side of the library from 10am-noon, unless otherwise stated. If there is rain, the session will be cancelled. Tie Dye sessions will have a rain date. **Please note**, there will still be take and make story time kits available for all themes and age groups, as well as take home craft kits for all planned crafts (except for Tie Dye).

Our program is designed for children ages 2 through 8th grade, or homeschool equivalent. The six week program runs from June 7th-July 16th. Please see the back for weekly details. Any questions, please call or e-mail Ms. Tiffany (tkaufmann@parliningersoll.org).

Reading Rules

1. Register through the library.
2. Children in grades K-8th read or listen to 120 minutes (2 hours) per week. Non-school aged children must have 10 books read to them a week.
3. Read books at your reading level.
4. Keep track of your minutes or books read each week.
5. Our volunteers will have your logs at the Summer Reading table, but you can fill them out. Once you return your filled log, you can pick out your prize for the week.
6. If you read more than the weekly goal, you may enter your name in our prize boxes for a chance to win a larger prize!

Incentives

Readers who meet their weekly reading goal will earn a small prize each week! Children will also get a chance to win bigger prizes for participating in any of our planned activities. A list of the bigger prizes can be found on our website, Facebook, or on the last board of our "Walk and Read" story.
