GROUND RULES

School age children can earn one stamp for every 30 minutes of reading they do. Younger children earn one stamp for every 30 minutes read to them. Keep track of your minutes. We will keep your reading logs here at the library. You will fill them out here, and then we will give you the number of stamps you have earned. Then you can choose a prize! One food coupon will be given to every child who turns in any amount of time read once per week. Once you complete 12 hours of reading, you earn a family ticket to the Pool Party at Big Creek Park July 25 (rain date July 27) and be entered to win one of the bigger prizes. Attending weekly story and craft/art activities times also will earn a chance to win a bigger prize, plus you can count it as reading time for your log!
